The Aetna member website (formerly Navigator) is your secure member website. All your health benefits, plan information and cost-savings tools are in one place. And it's available 24/7. You and your spouse, or domestic partner, can register and set up secure individual accounts.

How to get started

You can visit the New York Life microsite at **www.nylbenefits.com** and click on the link to the Aetna member website. Or just go directly to **www.aetna.com**, and click on the "Login" button at the top right of the page.

If you're a new user, follow these steps to complete registration:

- 1. Click on "Register now"
- 2. Enter your personal information
- 3. Create a secure log in
- 4. Set up your account preferences
- 5. Agree to the terms and conditions
- 6. Access your new account

How to access your incentives

- 1. Log in to the Aetna member website
- Click on the "Stay Healthy" tab
- 3. Click on "Access Wellness"
- 4. On your incentives tab
 - View available and completed incentives
 - See incentive dollars used for claims

How to access your account through PayFlex®

- 1. You can access your flexible spending account (FSA) or health reimbursement account (HRA) through the PayFlex member website.
 - Log in to the Aetna member website
 - Scroll to "Helpful Resources"
 - Click on "Spending/Savings account with PayFlex"
 - On the PayFlex site, you can:
 - View your account balance, payments and deposits
 - View earned incentive dollars
 - Submit a claim for eligible expenses you paid for out-of-pocket
- 2. You can also access your account through the PayFlex Mobile app*.
 - First, you'll need to create a username and password at <u>www.payflexdirect.com</u>. Click on Register Now to get started.
 - You can use the app to:
 - View your account activity
 - Submit a claim for eligible expenses you paid for out-of-pocket
 - View PayFlex card purchases and submit documentation
 - Receive alerts and notifications
 - View a list of eligible expense items
